-Comprehensive Examination can detect any physical changes that may require preventive measures. This includes eyes, ears, nose, dentition and oral health, and throat exam, heart and lung auscultation, gentle abdominal palpation, evaluation of coat and skin condition, body weight and temperature, external parasite check, and more. Because cats and dogs age quicker than us, taking them to the veterinarian once a year is like you going once in five to seven years!

-Annual blood testing will give us important information on kidney and liver values, diabetes, blood protein levels, and possible infection. This can help us detect changes BEFORE they become a problem. *We will test thyroid function in senior pets.*

-Urinalysis provides us information about the kidneys, bladder, liver, pancreas, and other organs. Urinalysis along with blood testing will give us an overall look at what is happening inside your pet. We can keep cats here to collect urine at no additional charge.

-SDMA Kidney Function test. This can help us detect changes BEFORE they become a problem.

-Stool Sample - The Center of Disease Control recommends fecal testing for intestinal parasites yearly. This is necessary with your examination especially if your pet travels or is around other animals. Intestinal parasites may also be contagious to humans

-Blood Pressure will be performed in senior cats as hypertension is a common old age ailment. This can be performed quickly and painlessly during your cat's office visit.
